Shushan Purim Concert with Moscow Male Jewish Choir, Saturday Night, March 26

Our Purim celebrations will continue on Saturday night March 26, with a concert by the Moscow Male Jewish Choir; the Cantorial soloist will be Cantor Netanel Herstik.

The Moscow Male Jewish Choir of the Academia of Cantonal Art was established in 1991. They have performed and popular-

ized a wide range of Jewish music: folk songs, liturgical repertoire, modern Jewish and Israeli vocal and choral compositions. While the Choir's home is the Moscow Marina Roscha Synagogue, their repertoire contains international classics and they participate in a myriad of cultural events organized by the Russian and Jewish communities. Since its inception, the ensemble has visited many cities and republics of the former USSR, as well as many countries around the world. Conductor Alexander Tsaliuk graduated from the Moscow Conservatory where he received his Master's degree in choral conducting. He wrote his Master's thesis on historical development of Jewish liturgical music and holds two PhD's in choral conducting and symphonic opera conducting. Since 1994 Tsaliuk has also been conducting the Moscow Oratorio, the diplomatic corps choir at the American Embassy

in Moscow.
