

The Moscow Male Jewish Choir is an extraordinary choir that has brought Russian Jewish music back to life after almost a century of oblivion.

The Choir has performed in more than 300 concerts in 12 western European countries and in such prestigious venues as the Moscow Conservatory; Tchaikovsky Hall in Moscow; Munich Academy of Music, and Teatron Yerushalaim in Jerusalem.

It's artistic director and conductor, Dr. Alexander Tsaliuk, has prepared many programs of Jewish liturgical music, Jewish and Russian folk music, and classical music. He entered the Tchaikovsky State Conservatory's choral conducting program at the age of 15. He earned his master's degree four years later and his doctorate with honors in 1996.

This Purim Concert is a featured event of the Manhattan Beach Jewish Center's Annual Purim Jewish Music Festival and recognizes the strength, vitality, and contributions being made by the Russian - American Jewish community.
